Further Notes on Wedding Photograph

It's vital to identify 8 and 9 on the marriage photo; no.9 appears to be wearing national dress, with the hat similar to traditional Latvian ones; they're both wearing the same badges/medals so think they've come together.

No.4, 17 are daughters of the mysterious Sarah Jane Dashper.

No.16, 17 are the guardians of the 3 orphans (1,11,12).

No.6 is my grandfather, no.11 my grandmother.

Of the 6 ladies identified on the maternal side, 4 are named with Lena or some close variant.
