The competition is for employees between the ages of 16 and 25 (inclusive), working in the former Tynedale Area. They must have been in post for a minimum of six months and not have been a previous winner of the awards.

The competition is designed to encourage young people in Tynedale to learn and develop new skills and gain valuable work experience, to contribute to the success of their company or organisation and in turn to contribute to the successful development of the area.

The competition is organised by the Rotary Club of Hexham and supported by its main sponsors, including Hexham Town Council.

The organizers are looking for young employees, who have a positive attitude to work and learning, have achieved good relations with their work colleagues and their employer and are making an outstanding contribution to their company or organisation.

The Winner will receive the Jack Charlton Trophy to keep for one year and £500. Second place will receive the JB Jonas Trophy and £250, third place will receive a trophy and £100. All finalists will receive a certificate to commemorate their success at a Rotary Meeting. It is a stipulation that prize money is to be spent on personal development, ie) courses, books, materials, equipment, mentoring, coaching or visits to other firms to benchmark performance etc.

Interviews of Finalists: Friday 9 May 2025

Presentation of Awards: Monday 9 June 2025
